An architecturally designed series of three large townhouses close to Clapham Common. Jeremy Rye Studio was asked to design the hard and soft landscape scheme for one of the houses and to work in conjunction with the new owners to deliver a garden specific to their requirements, whilst working within the architectural language of the new development.

Challenges were to create a garden with a significant level change that would work across the whole garden but deliver both an area for family and parties and an area for quiet reflection and intimate dining.

The planting scheme was developed with the owner using plants from their previous house and interweaving new planting that would tie the scheme together and reflecting their love of painting and art but within a modern and contemporary house context.

This project was completed December 2015.
